Zucchini Tots

Ingredients:

2 medium zucchini (12 oz.)

1 large egg

- 1/2 cup grated pecorino
- 1/2 cup panko (or breadcrumbs or crackers)

1 clove garlic, crushed with garlic press

1/2 tsp. black pepper

Directions:

- 1. Step 1, Preheat oven to 400°F. Coat one large baking sheet with nonstick cooking spray. Shred zucchini and squeeze dry with paper or fabric towels. Mix shredded zucchini with egg, pecorino, panko, garlic, and pepper.
- 2. Step 2, Use a small cookie scoop to drop tablespoonfuls of mixture onto prepared baking sheet. Then, shape each into a small log. Bake in 400°F oven, turning halfway through, until golden brown, 20 to 22 minutes.

AIR FRYER INSTRUCTIONS: Heat air fryer to 375°F. Brush basket with oil; place half of tots in basket and air-fry, shaking occasionally, until golden brown, 6 minutes.

Tip: Make these tots ahead of time and refrigerate for up to 3 days. Pop them in a toaster oven on a piece of foil and toast on a dark setting, heat to re-crisp.
