Pumpkin Dump Cake

15 oz. Pumpkin Puree
12 oz Evaporated Milk
1 cup brown sugar
3 LG eggs
2 teaspoon Pumpkin pie spice
1 box yellow or spice cake. 15.25 oz
2 sticks UNSALTED butter
1 cup chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
9x13 pan, buttered on bottom and sides.

1. Combine Pumpkin, evaporated milk, brown sugar, eggs, and spice. Whisk until combined. Pour into pan.
2. Sprinkle the Cake mix on top of batter evenly.
3. Sprinkle pecans evenly over the batter.
4. Pour melted butter over Cake. Bake 45-50 minutes until edges are brown and center is set. A knife inserted in the middle should come out clean. Can be served warm with whipped cream or cold.
